
#### To those who have visited Japan before,

Please upload a photo of the entry and departure stamps of Japan in your passport. If the stamps are in your old passport, please also upload a photo page of your old passport. Please be sure to submit ALL the stamps (both entry and departure) in your passport(s) if you have entered Japan multiple times.



To those who have visited Japan before but went through an automated gate and did not get a departure stamp when you left Japan,

Instead of the departure stamp, please upload a copy of your flight itinerary or e-ticket that proves the departure date.



- This photo will be used for your NUFS student ID card and the CoE application.
- Do not upload a scan of the actual photo.

#### **Photo requirements**

- The image should be clear and in color.
- Only the applicant should be in the photo.
- Must be taken within the past 3 months, showing current appearance.
- Do not wear a hat or headgear that obscures the hair or hair line.
- Full face, front view with a plain white or off-white background.
- There should be spaces above and beside the face.
- Must be saved as a jpg file.
- Photo size: under 50KB, 330 pixels wide x 440 pixels in height (3:4)





- Please upload a full academic transcript from your home institution including grading scale.
- ➤ Your academic record showing the total number of credits you have earned to date in your current institution is required.

Bank Statement in English



- ➤ Please provide a bank statement, a letter from the bank confirming your funds or a certificate of deposit. This document is required to show that you have adequate funds for your stay in Japan and it must be issued within 3 months prior to the application deadline.
- ➤ If your parents pay for your living expenses during your stay at NUFS, a bank statement of your parents' account will be acceptable. In this case, please upload a document certifying parent-child relationship (e.g. birth certificate) as well.

#### Students who apply for the NUFS scholarship >

The minimum required balance should amount to 40,000 yen for each month.

- Study period of 1 semester:  $40,000 \text{ yen } \times 5 \text{ months} = 200,000 \text{ yen}$
- Study period of 1 academic year: 40,000 yen x 10 months = 400,000 yen

## < Students who do NOT apply for the NUFS scholarship >

The minimum required balance should amount to 100,000 yen for each month.

- Study period of 1 semester: 100,000 yen x 5 months = 500,000 yen
- Study period of 1 academic year: 100,000 yen x 10 months = 1,000,000 yen



- This form must be filled out and signed by a physician. Please upload the scan of the completed form.
- Students with pre-existing medical conditions should stay in touch with the physician in charge of their treatment in their home countries, as some medical services or treatments may not be available in Japan.



- Please upload a written agreement for the medical condition, treatment, medication and medical history listed on the Medical Information Form.
- You do not need to submit this agreement in case no condition, treatment, medication or medical history has been mentioned in the Medical Information Form.


